Room news: 11/30 is now our cut off birthdate for the King's Kids year with graduation in August.
Using The Gospel Project, our King's Kids teachers work hard each week to draw your kids into God's word, the Bible. Make sure you ask them "What did you learn today?" and work on their unit memory verse!

Mom & Infant Nursing/Quiet Room The office conference room is now complete with a speaker to hear the sermon while you care for your bundle of joy! No siblings, please!

Room 3 (Meadow) Starting 8/27, the TKC baby boom requires only babies 4mo - walkers be in this room. We will now have an on-call baby holder if it gets busy!

Room 4 (Aquarium) Walkers -There is a changing area in this room and they will be offered a snack. The focus of this room will be play, stories, songs and getting to know new friends!

Room 1 (Farm) This room for our youngest preschoolers has a schedule of activities (singing, stories, snack and game) and uses the Toddler Gospel Project Curriculum. It also has a bathroom.

Room 2 (Jungle) This room is for our preschoolers and has a schedule of activities (singing, stories, snack, craft and game). It uses the Gospel Project Curriculum. It also has a bathroom.

Room 5 (Upstairs) PK class - This class is for the oldest preschoolers and utilizes the full Gospel Project Preschool Curriculum. They are dismissed from the sanctuary at the end of worship and will be led upstairs by their teacher.

King's Kids Church K-5 (Upstairs Rm7/8) Our elementary children will be released to their teachers after worship from the sanctuary side door. Upstairs in Rm 8, all the children will sing and do the Bible lesson together. After the lesson, the Lower Elementary (K-2) will stay in Rm 8 while the Upper Elementary (3-5) will go to Rm 7 and do grade appropriate activities that reinforce the lesson and also work on the Unit Memory Verse through games and fun. Please pick up these children by showing your security code at the door at the end of the service - K-2nd in Rm 8 and 3rd-5th in Rm 7.
