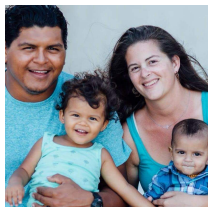


In Sept '17, we will begin a King's Kids Choir for 3rd-6th graders with Pastor Reeve and Ms. Annie. Stay tuned for details!

King's Kids curriculum

The Gospel Project® (TGP) is a chronological, Christ-centered Bible study for Kids and Students that examines how all Scripture gives testimony to Jesus Christ. Over the course of three years, participants will journey from Genesis to Revelation and discover how God's plan of redemption unfolds throughout Scripture and still today, compelling them to join the mission of God. After 16 months, the King's Kids will complete the Old Testament at the end of February! In March, the journey through the New Testament begins. Please make sure to thank your child's teachers for their love and commitment! On the way home from church, share what you learned and then ask your kids - "What did you learn today? Did you meet any new friends? What is the memory verse for this unit? Did you play any games? Show me your take home sheet!"
