**Questions for Small Groups:**

1. How did the covetousness of idolatry (wanting and lusting after things which are not intended for them) hurt the Corinthian people?
2. The Jewish people were chosen by God to be "a light to the gentiles". Instead they often gave in to evil desires. How might sexual immorality hurt and divide the church in Corinth?
3. When we test God by doing that which he disapproves of (ex. cheating on our taxes) and constantly demanding from Him that which is forbidden by Him. Are we not opening ourselves up to tragic consequences? Illustrate by appropriate examples from your own life.
4. What is the danger of whining or grumbling about God's authority in our life, sometimes represented by those humans in authority over us? Why do we do it? Does it help us or hinder us and why?
